This is a closed NSSA registered shoot. Any shooter residing in a Zone 7 State who is a member in good standing of their State Association and NSSA is eligible to shoot the Zone 7 Championships. Rules and procedures of the 2026 NSSA Rule Book will be observed.

Registration: Please have your classification card up to date prior to registering. Any shooter who is incorrectly classed due to their error shall forfeit all prizes and optional purses. No refunds will be given. It is the responsibility of the shooter to verify their event entries and classes are correct before leaving registration.

Registration for each event/gauge will close at the start of the last rotation for that event/gauge.

Payment methods for entry fees: CASH and CHECK only. No credit/debit cards will be accepted for entry fees.

Award Eligibility: It is the shooter's responsibility to make sure they have been entered into the correct classes and concurrent.

To enter the HOA, shooter must enter the events making up the HOA. Entry in open/class HOA/HAA is not required for entry in a concurrent HOA/HAA. However, entry in all of the individual concurrent events comprising the concurrent HOA/HAA is required. A shooter not classified in all events can enter the HOA and HAA but will be placed in the highest class available.

Teams: Members of a team event do not have to shoot on the same squad. To enter an HOA team event, all members of the team must remain the same for the events that make up the HOA. Team must be declared before any member has shot the event that the team is entering.

Rookie Concurrent: Per NSSA rule, Section II-I-7, an individual who was not classified in any gauge with receipt of their current classification card and has never had an initial classification or regular classification in 2025 or prior years in any gauge. A shooter is only eligible to compete as Rookie for one shooting year in their lifetime.

Squad Times: It is the shooter's responsibility to be at the **correct field at the correct time**. Shooters are requested to be at their field 20 minutes before rotation time. We encourage you to start shooting if your field is open and the squad and referee are ready earlier than the scheduled time. Shooters missing their scheduled squad time accept the risk of not shooting the event. Field changes to squad order are not permitted. See registration for all squad order change requests.

Proofs: All proof shells are the responsibility of the shooter.

Practice Rates and Fields: Zone shooters will be charged member rates for practice. The club will be open on Wednesday 10 am – 5 pm and Thursday 9 am – 5 pm. Designated field(s) may be available for practice on Friday through Sunday. If practice is allowed on tournament fields, all shooters must be off the field 30 minutes before a flight is scheduled for that field. Unauthorized practice will be subject to disqualification from this shoot.

Refunds and Withdrawals: Refunds of deposit will be made for cancellations received by July 31, 2026. After this date, refunds will be at the discretion of shoot management. Refunds of target fees, purse and option monies will be given for notified withdrawals prior to the start of the event. If the event has already started, only target fees will be refunded for notified withdrawals. No refunds will be given for withdrawals due to weather or no-shows.

Scores and Scoreboard: Shooters must check their scores prior to leaving the field. The scoreboard is for reference only. Official scores are within the computer system and are official when printed and posted to NSSA.

Shootoffs: Shootoffs will be posted when available. All initial shootoffs will be announced over a PA system if available. Shooters providing a cell phone number may receive shootoff alerts via texts from www.iskeet.org. Shooters should report back to shootoff area for possible continuations prior to leaving the area. Ties will be shot off with Doubles at 3-4-5 total by station. Concurrent event shootoffs will run concurrent with other shootoffs whenever possible. Team shootoffs will be shot separately.

Award Presentation: Following shootoffs each day, an Olympic style award ceremony will be held for events completed that day. Champion, Runner-up and Third will receive their awards at this time. An awards table will be set up near registration where shooters can pick up awards the day following the end of the event. Awards for events concluding on Sunday will be available as results are posted.

Payouts: All payouts will be mailed.

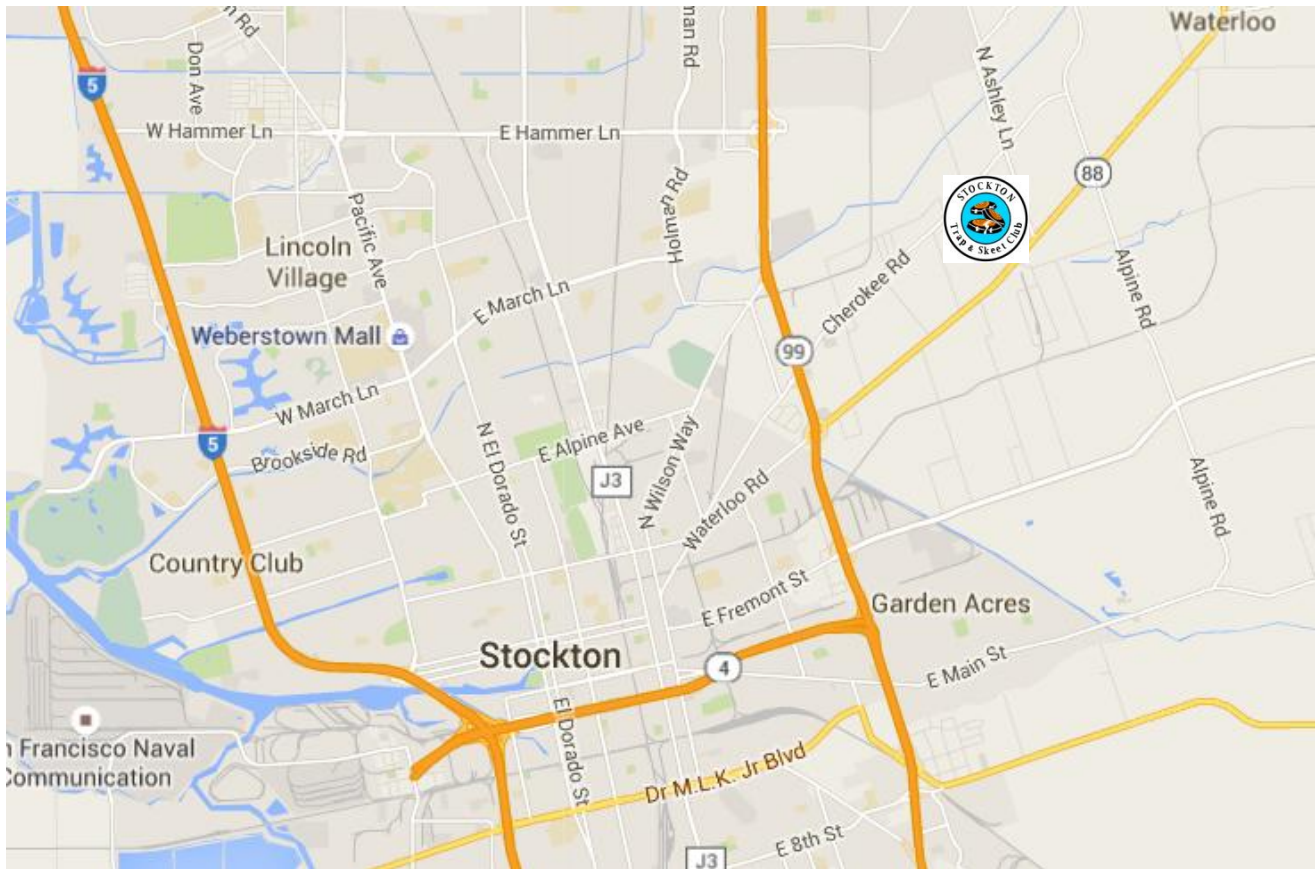
